*This private residence utilizes a series of landscape walls to mediate the connection of the building to the surrounding landscape. These heavy stone walls move through the building, creating distinct zones between public and private space. The parti is separated into three volumes, which include the main house, guesthouse and garage. The hinge pin between these spaces is an inspiring Zen garden which is integral to the entrance sequence. Measuring approximately 10,500 sq ft., the residence is structured with a steel moment frame and "cranked" beams to support the compound roof pitches. My involvement in this project included model building and assisting the project manager in creating construction drawings used to secure a building permit.*
