In 1994 Bruno Architecture completed an understated 2,000 s.f. shingle style cottage for a private family on 45+ acres of oceanfront property. Ten years later we were asked to substantially increase the program resulting in approximately fifty percent demolition of the original structure and a final size of 4,200 s.f. This project stayed in active design development for over a year before final construction drawings were issued. Collaboration and perseverance yielded a sophisticated new plan with tremendous views over Union River Bay. What was once a small uninsulated cottage is now a comfortable year-round family home with high-end finishes and amenities. The rooms are arranged to capture the best views and facilitate separate zones for the family and those visiting overnight. I was involved in this project from schematic design through construction drawings and was responsible for the production of the twenty-nine sheet set with oversight from the principals.
